

Temporary suspension of the JPs in the Community program

Witnessing services at all JPs in the Community signing sites have been temporarily suspended effective from Tuesday, 11 January 2022 until Monday, 7 February 2022.

The services of Justices of the Peace (JP) and Commissioners for Declarations (Cdec) are available using the after-hours search or the Queensland Volunteer Online Witnessing Service (QVOWS).

Face to face witnessing service

You can access the services of a JP or Cdec using our after-hours search to have your documents witnessed.

Eligible face to face documents include:

- Titles Queensland documents,
 - Including Transfer and National Mortgage forms
- Commonwealth documents, including statutory declarations
- Certifying copies of documents
- Enduring powers of attorney and advance health directives
- Wills.

Online witnessing service

You can have your eligible Queensland and Federal Circuit Court and Family Court of Australia documents witnessed by a JP or Cdec.

Eligible online documents include:

- Queensland Statutory declarations
- Affidavits
- General power of attorney
- Deeds
- Federal Circuit Court and Family Court of Australia documents.
